As of 1 May 2019, the coordinates of the High Risk Area in the Indian Ocean will be changed. The new coordinates of the High Risk Area are:

In the Southern Red Sea: Northern Limit: Latitude 15° 00'N In the Indian Ocean a line linking:

From the territorial waters off coast of east Africa at Latitude $05\,^{\circ}$ 00'S to $050\,^{\circ}$ 00'E Then to positions:

Lat: 00° 00' N Long: 055° 00' E

Lat: 10° 00' N Long: 060° 00' E

Lat: 14° 00' N Long: 060° 00' E

Then a bearing 310° to the territorial waters off the Arabian Peninsula.

This change will take effect on 1 May 2019

The industry associations will continue to monitor developments to the security situation and will adjust the HRA again if and when the situation warrants it.
